My brilliant Bodies	All bodies are different and all bodies can do different things
Internal body parts	heart, lungs, blood, stomach, intestines, brain
New born baby	New babies are very small and not able to do very much when they are born. They mostly sleep and eat.
Then and Now	Things you could do as a baby, a toddler and things you can do now.
Unkind	When someone says something that is not nice, or hurtful but they do this only once (a one-off).
Tease	When someone makes fun of or jokes about someone but only once (a one-off).
Bully	When someone is repeatedly unkind or hurtful to another person (it's ongoing, not a one-off).
Secret	Something that is kept or meant to be kept unknown or unseen by others.
Surprise	An unexpected or astonishing event
Private parts	External genitalia e.g. vulva, vagina, penis, testicles
Safe	Protected from harm or danger.
