- Begin to talk about and act out things I have experienced.

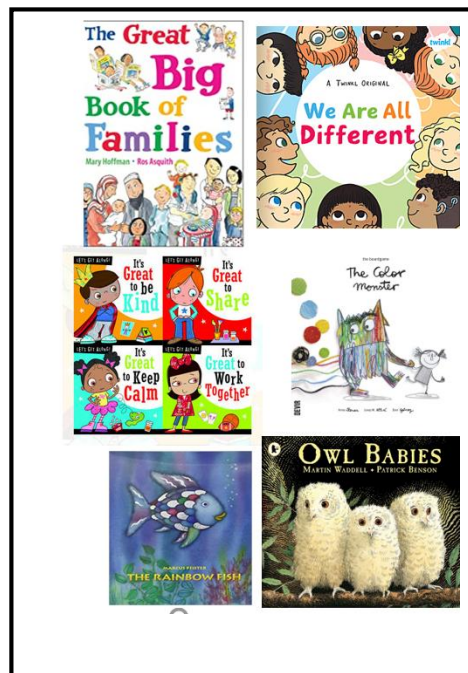
