Weekly Homework tasks

We expect the following tasks to be completed weekly by all children:

- Practise spellings weekly
- Reading (at least 3 times per week, signed in their reading record by an adult)
- Rock Star maths (3 times per week for at least 15 minutes)

Optional Tasks

Here are some additional tasks which your child may complete and should be handed in on Monday the following week.

PROJECT	Design and create your own theatre mask inspired by those from the Ancient Greek theatre productions.
TASK 1 W.B. 6.09.20	Create a postcard for the Greek Tourist Board showing nice things about modern Greece.
TASK 2 W.B. 13.09.20	Create your own God/Goddess. What are they God of? What are their weapons and powers? What is their symbol? Could you create the beast which they have or need to destroy?
TASK 3 W.B. 20.09.20	Research popular Greek foods. Design a menu using these foods.
TASK 4 W.B. 27.09.20	Research Archimedes, who was the Greek mathematician, physicist, engineer, inventor and astronomer set an important challenge by King Hiero II. Draw a picture of his "Eureka!" moment.
TASK 5 W.B. 02.10.20	Design your own Olympic sport and write instructions for how to take part in it. Can you design your own Olympic medal for the winners?
TASK 6 <u>11.10.20</u>	In Greek Mythology, a labyrinth was a complicated confusing structure made to hold a Minotaur. Create your own Labyrinth. You could use straws, string, lego pieces or draw it on paper.
