Year 4 Summer Curriculum Overview

As mathematicians we will learn about:

- Write fiction stories based on a text.

As readers we will:

- Retrieve information from a range of different styles of text.
- Use clues to infer information from a range of different styles of text.
- Listen to and discuss poetry.
- Explore Roald Dahl's books.

As communicators we will:

- Use Duolingo to practise listening, speaking and spelling in French!

As historians we will:

- Study the history of chocolate throughout the world.
- Study life of Roald Dahl.
- Investigate local history linked to chocolate producers.
